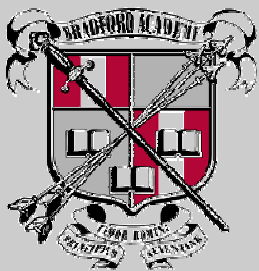
BRADFORD ACADEMY'S PARENT UPDATE

**1st Phonics:** Final silent e , Y as long e and long i

**1st Math:** Sums of 11, making an organized list, naming fractional parts, and writing a fraction

**1st Grammar:** Common nouns and proper nouns

**2nd Phonics:** Final stable syllables

**2nd Math:** Adding 7 and 8, telling time to 5 minute intervals, identifying a.m. and p.m. and identifying the number of minutes in an hour and number of hours in a day

**2nd Grammar:** Article Adjectives

**2nd Latin:** audi: listen, tace: be quiet, aperi librum: open the book, attole manum: raise your hand

**4th Art:** Rembrandt

**4th Music:** This week the students learned about a tie and what it does to the value of a note. They also continued to practice "Country Dance" and "Blue Jeans".
