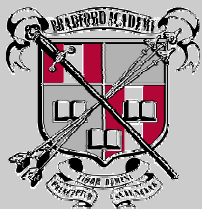
BRADFORD ACADEMY'S PARENT UPDATE

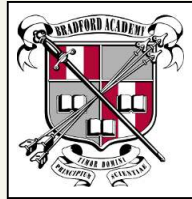
**4th grade Art:** Contour Tubes

**4th Latin:** LfC B - Ch. 30

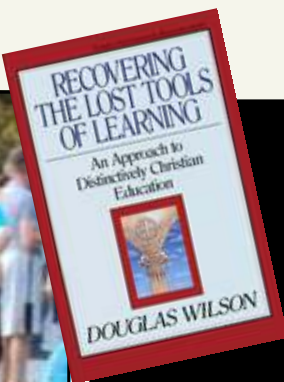
**1st History:** We learned about the stock market crash of 1929 and the Great Depression
